



Origami flower.


Step 1. Fold your square in half, width ways and then unfold.



Step 2. Fold your square in half, length ways and then unfold.



Step 3. Fold your square into a triangle.



Step 4. Fold the two bottom corners of your triangle in so that the base line meets the embossed fold line you made from the previous folds.




Step 5. Fold over the points you have made so they are flat and in line with the base edge.

Step 6. Open back out and fold your edges in.

Step 7. Look at your template.

Add glue to the areas that say glue. Fold the paper over to make the numbers match. For example, fold the glue area with the number 1 to the other area that has 1 written on it.




Step 8. Turn over your template.

This will show you the area on the back the will need to be glued.

This is easier to do once you have glued the other side and the paper is starts to curl up into a 3d shape.

Pinch the area until the glue has dried. This is one of your petals. You will need to repeat this process 6 times as you will need 6 petals.



Step 9. Once you have made 6 petals they can be glued together to make a flower.
